

JEWS, JUDAISM, AND THE WAY

- Silversmith guild caused a riot in Ephesus
- Silversmiths saw The Way as part of Judaism
- The Way considered themselves as part of Judaism
- Mainstream Jews agreed that The Way was part of Judaism
- Some gentiles were part of it, but that had been so since the exodus from Egypt




BENEDICTION AGAINST HERETICS



In time Rabbis claimed that The Way was heretical

- Just before 100 A.D. the *Birkat ha-Minim* was enacted
- Book of benedictions called Shemoneh Esrei


 Aimed at Jews of The Way....not at Christians (gentiles)



Other NT books also deal with Paul's journeys

Paul left Ephesus, went to Troas expecting to meet Titus there

- Paul left for Macedonia to finally meet up with Titus
- Went to Greece for 3 months (wintered there)
- Elders came to Corinth to meet with Paul, and then sail with him to Jerusalem to deliver the contributions for the poor




- A plot to kill Paul is uncovered, so Paul alters his plans
- Elders sail to Troas as planned, while Paul takes a different ship
- Didn't leave until "Days of Matzah" ended
- Passover and Matzah used interchangeably in common speech
- In 7 weeks Shavuot would arrive and Paul wanted to be in Jerusalem to obey the commandment to come to the Temple for the pilgrimage festival(s)

MOTZA'EI SHABBAT

- > Acts 20:7 Big changes?
- Motza'ei Shabbat = departure of the Sabbath
- Shabbat ends at sunset
- Motza'ei Shabbat is not a Biblical command; is a Tradition
- After sunset, meal was prepared and eaten
- To begin evening meal, a barakah is spoken, and the bread is broken and passed around







- Paul was not changing or adding anything !
- Dr. David Stern
- Which day for worship?
- No Biblical concept of a designated Day of Worship & no days are prohibited
- > 2) Shabbat is a day of rest and nothing else
- Saturday (Shabbat) meeting for synagogue is a Jewish Tradition
- > 4) Sunday is NOT a pagan day....God created all 7 days
- Motza'ei Shabbat is done on Sunday!

WORSHIP DAY Saturday or Sunday?


Custom or Commandment?





- 5) Constantine (and the Church) ABOLISHED Sabbath, created the Lord's Day to be held on Sundays
- 6) NOTHING wrong with meeting on Saturdays for worship, just as nothing wrong with meeting on Sundays for worship...neither has more merit than the other....both are manmade customs and traditions
- But.....Shabbat is always the 7th day and cannot be changed by humans







LUKE IS BACK

- About midnight, a young man named Eutychus fell asleep on a window ledge and fell 3 stories!
 Hit the pavement and died
- Paul embraces him and he comes alive
- Luke, a doctor, was an eye witness
- Time to leave Troas, but Paul decides to walk to Assos while the others take a ship

PAUL DECLARES HIS FAITHFULNESS

- From Assos to Mitylene, then to Chios, then to Samos, and finally to Miletus
- Pauls summons Elders from Ephesus because he thought he would not ever see them again
- A good example is more powerful than good words
- Paul says he taught the same beneficial reality to Jews and gentiles: repentance and faith in Christ







REPENTANCE: THE ELIGIBILITY TEST

- First, before Grace, comes repentance
- Both repentance AND trust in Christ are needed
- Repentance and trusting in Christ are separate events
- The Law shows that you are a sinner
- But Yeshua is the only means to PAY for your sins
- Substitution. First was animals, then Yeshua once and for all !

No Repentance, NO SALVATION

- "Un-victorious Christians" (an oxymoron) are those who think that they can have Salvation without sincere repentance.....but they can't
- > All Christians (Believers) are victorious! We have been handed an eternal victory!
- > Turning from sin is an act of the human will
- Trust in the Lord Yeshua and receiving forgiveness is an act of divine Grace

PREPARE FOR THE ATTACK

Paul predicts that something bad will happen at Jerusalem

- Turns out, he did go back to Ephesus later on
- Paul speaks to the leadership of Ephesus about their duty to protect the sheep
- Wolves from within and without will come with deviant doctrines
