



THE FOG OF END TIMES PROPHECY

- Many interpretations, each with its own merit and problems
- When fog is dense, we can barely make out objects
- When fog thins, shapes can be recognized
- More thinning and nearer objects come into view, but far away objects are still not identifiable
- The End Times prophetic fog was thickest in John's day, but more detail is discernible in our time

7TH BOWL AIR IT IS DONE!

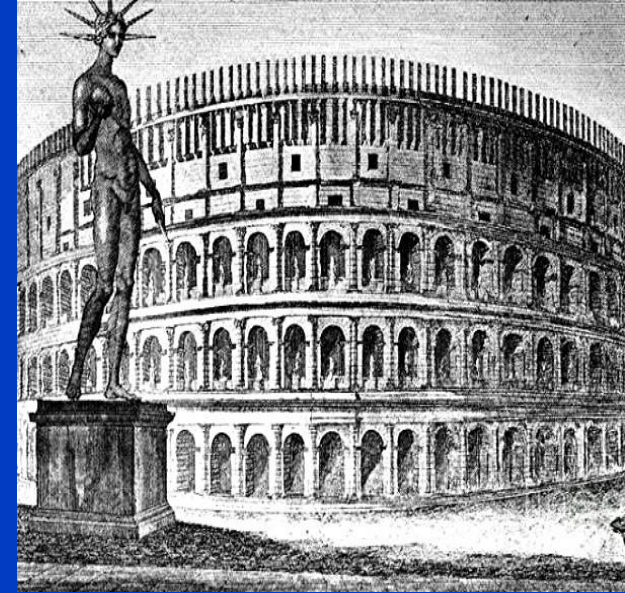


- No scriptural explanation of how this affected the “air”
- This completes the cycle of judging the 4 Elements of Nature: earth, water, fire, air
- Bible does not try to teach the 4 Elements as truth; rather it was a widespread belief from around the 6th century B.C. right up until the early 1800’s A.D.
- God speaks to us in terms used within our era and our culture

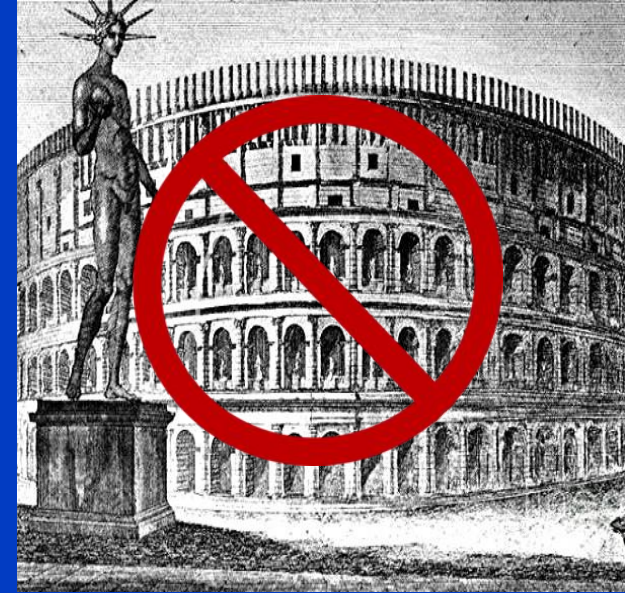
THE FINAL JUDGMENT



- Heavenly Temple needs to be compared to the Earthly Temple to gain meaning
- God is the One who announces “It is done”
- Lightning, voices, thunder and earthquake are like at Mt. Sinai
- Earthquake described as the greatest in the history of mankind



- The “great city”: Jerusalem, Babylon, or Rome ?
- Rev. 11:8 refers to ***“the great city...where their Lord was executed on a stake.”***
- “Great city” doesn’t indicate great merit, but rather great importance or influence
- Judging Babylon is the main theme of what is happening in Revelation
- Rev. 18:10 refers to ***“Oh no! The great city! Babel..”***
- Rome is nowhere mentioned, based on doctrine



- Jerusalem = City of Peace
- Arabs call it Al Quds
- Jerusalem already faced judgment in Rev. 11
- Rome presents no scriptural evidence
- Based on Christian belief that the Anti-Christ's Kingdom will be a reconstituted Roman Empire
- The real but rebuilt Babylon would put the world's financial and commerce capital in the Middle East!



- We do not know who the “great city” of End Times is yet
- It will have the character of Babylon, but likely won’t be named Babylon
- The “great city” and “cities of the nations” will share the character of Babylon the Great
- Jerusalem will have the character of Sodom and Egypt, but NOT the character of Babylon



- Early Church Fathers took the islands fleeing and mountains disappearing allegorically
- Pacific Ring of Fire responsible for 90% of all quakes
- New islands formed and old ones obliterated at times
- Every Egyptian plague except death of the firstborns has been re-created for the End Times

REVELATION CHAPTER 17

- Final judgment of Babylon first spoken of in Rev. 14:8
- John's visions not being given in chronological order
- Sometimes a prophecy is made, and later on details are added
- This is an extension of the Bowl Judgments
- Vs. 2 says the Harlot has committed adultery with many kings and nations
- World leaders and citizens desire to come into union with her, to be like her, and to have what she has



- Whatever is God's character, Satan's is the opposite
- The Harlot contaminates her partners with impurity
- ***Porneia*** = fornication, immorality
- "Making a deal with the Devil" in order to acquire something important to us
- God sees our willingness to join ourselves to the wicked and immoral as spiritual defection



GOD SHOWS MERCY TO ISRAEL

- Some Bible teachers declare that Israel is the Harlot of Babylon
- Biblically, Babylon always represents the antithesis of all that is promised to Israel
- Israel has not remained pure, but God shows them mercy
- Ezekiel 37:21 – 28
- God deals harshly with Babylon
- Revelation 18:21
- Revelation 19:1 - 3



THE 2 WOMEN OF REVELATION



- John carried off in spirit to a wilderness
- Woman sitting on a beast with 7 heads & 10 horns
- Satan is mocking and mimicking God
- Rev. 12:1 & 5 – 8
- Rev. 12 happens in Heaven, Rev. 17 happens on earth
- War in Heaven has happened, and God won!
- War is about to begin on earth, Battle of Armageddon
