DEUTERONOMY 10: OBLIGATIONS TO YHWH

- "O, Israel, what does YHWH your God demand of you?"
- > REVERE Him
- > WALK in His ways
- LOVE Him
- SERVE Him
- > OBEY His laws and commands
- These are instructions for the already redeemed, not for non-Believers!



How do you want to be loved?



A good man knows how to say "I love you" in French, Italian.....and Female

- The Lord demands He be loved in a certain way
- Humans also want to be loved in certain ways
- Without the desired demonstration of love, then the relationship suffers
- The Lord demands OBEDIENCE as the primary means of demonstrating love towards Him

CIRCUMCISED HEARTS




In the Bible, Heart = Mind


- Circumcise your <u>thoughts</u>
- The metaphor of circumcision means to remove the impenetrable covering
- Circumcision was the sign of the Abrahamic Covenant
- Stiff-necked = stubborn
- God's justice is unique
- Special care for widows and orphans
- YHWH also loves foreigners (ger)
- Jesus uses the same principles

DEUTERONOMY 11: GOD REACHING TOWARDS ISRAEL

- Moses' sermon thus far about Israel's history, Wilderness experiences, God's election of Israel
- Israel must ratify God's offer (covenant) by:
- a) Agreeing with itb) Following it's terms



REJECTION OF GOD'S OFFER MEANS ISRAEL BECOMES COMMON



- First step is that Israel must decide to accept or reject the offer of relationship with God
- Rejection makes Israel just like all other nations....it does NOT make them cursed!

Acceptance means NOW they are subject to receive blessings for obedience and curses for violations according to the terms of the covenant

WHO WAS THE NEW COVENANT WITH?

- Jer.31:31 "Behold.....I will make a new covenant with <u>the house of</u> <u>Israel and the house of Judah</u>..."
- So, how does a gentile (a foreigner) gain access to the New Covenant?
- Faith in the Jewish Messiah, Yeshua!
- When we accept that covenant, we accept ALL of its terms, not just the convenient ones




ONCE ACCEPTED THE ISSUE IS OBEDIENCE OR DISOBEDIENCE



Nothing gained or lost by saying "no" to the offer
 However, once accepted the terms are now in effect and violating the terms means penalties

Deuteronomy 11 presumes the offer HAS been accepted, so now Moses says they MUST be obedient





OBEDIENCE THE KEY TO BEING BLESSED IN CANAAN

Egypt and Canaan compared and contrasted

- In Egypt, Israel had to work hard to grow food
- No rain in Egypt, water from the Nile
- In Canaan, the Lord would water the land from rain
- Egypt's fruitfulness was in the people's hands

God says He watches out over Canaan


A DIFFERENT SYSTEM IN CANAAN

- Rains dependent on obedience
- And, the great blessings of abundance and fertility were not to result in the worship of Canaanite gods!
- Therefore, Israel is to use the reminders God gave to them....Tzitzit, Mezuzahs, Tefillin....



IDEAL TERRITORY DEFINED

- To this point Israel has never possessed all the territory
- Kings David and
 Solomon came the closest



COVENANT RENEWAL CEREMONY



- Mosaic Covenant to be reaffirmed AFTER Israel enters the Promised Land
- This will be the 3rd time
- Mt. Sinai, Moab, then in Canaan
- Standard procedure in that day to renew or reaffirm covenants when leaving one territory and entering another
- They thought different spiritual authorities were involved



Covenant renewal ceremony will take place near Shechem Mt. Ebal Mt. Gerizim Gerizim is SOUTH of Shechem, Ebal is NORTH of Shechem South = right North = left **Blessings** pronounced from Gerizim **Curses from Ebal**
