- Overriding Godprinciple:
- We have a choice when offered a Covenant relationship with the Lord
- We can either reject that offer, or enter into a Covenant relationship with Him
- That Covenant HAS terms and obligations


# THE LAW WAS A RADICAL DEPARTURE FROM THE NORM FOR ISRAEL

- Our Constitution was somewhat revolutionary, but elements of it had been tried before
- > An IDEAL of self-governance
- Rome and Magna Carta
- Until Moses, it had been a king who established each society's laws
- That <u>a god</u> would be the one who created laws by which all would abide was new






## ANCIENT POEM: "THE PRAYER TO EVERY GOD"

  - Will help us to understand the mindset of the ancient world at the time of Moses




# YHWH MAKES HIMSELF KNOWN


- World's religious systems were pathetic
- Yehoveh explains all: who He is, His laws, His expectations, His unchanging nature
- The transition from the universal understanding of the world of the gods to the Laws and love of God were difficult and uneven for Israel
- Paul says we owe a debt to the Jewish people for their bringing God's Word and God's Messiah to us!

# MAJOR SHIFT IN ISRAELI SOCIETY

- Israel about to move from being wandering herders, to a settled agrarian society
- They will settle over several thousand square miles of Canaan
- In the Wilderness they ALL encamped around the Tabernacle
- In Canaan: WHERE will they worship and sacrifice?







#### HIGH PLACES

- Rule #1: Destroy the High Places of the pagan gods
- > **Shaddai** = mountain
- > Akkadian, Ugarit
- El Shaddai = God of the Mountain
- A High Place is a religious worship site that is at a higher elevation than its surroundings



## GROVES, POLES AND STANDING STONES

Asherah literally means "grove"

Common to construct an altar under Evergreen trees


Evergreen tree standard symbol of fertility

Can refer to "poles", similar to Totem Poles


Standing stones were either monuments or objects of worship

## ALTARS, ALTARS EVERYWHERE!

- Among the pagans no authorization needed to build an altar to a god
- Private altars to personal gods were common
- Altars erected nearby for convenience
- God says Israel is NOT to do this!
- Israel is to have ONE place of worship and sacrifice even in Canaan!




# HIGH PLACE FOR ONE GOD COULD BE BUILT NEXT TO A HIGH PLACE FOR A DIFFERENT GOD



- A High Place and Altar typically was for worship of only certain god (s)
- But, as circumstances changed a High Place might be converted to worship a different or new god
- Israel is NOT to co-locate any Canaanite High Place with a place to worship Yehoveh

### HEAVENLY IDEAL VS. EARTHLY REALITY



- The central sanctuary (Tabernacle) was moved several times in Canaan
- The command to destroy
   ALL pagan high places was
   a heavenly ideal, never
   accomplished
- IDEAL = an expression of perfection
- Israel also never attained all land set aside by God as a heavenly ideal
- All of God's ideals WILL BE eventually attained on earth

## WHY WE NEED A MESSIAH

- God's IDEALS cannot be brought about while depraved men still rule the world
- Adam was created to be an IDEAL MAN, but he FELL
- Messiah Yeshua is the NEW IDEAL MAN
- God's covenants did NOT fail!
- God's creatures (man) failed!
