MORAL CHOICE VS. PREFERENCE

- The Human Will makes moral choices
- Preferences are personal and intellectual and does not involve morality
- Without moral choices available, our Wills cannot function
- The Law provides for those moral choices
- Without the Law (moral choice) sin is impossible



GOD DIVIDES AND SEPARATES



The very first Law God gave to Man concerned food

He used food to demonstrate His principle of distinctions

God's preeminent activity is dividing and separating


Food was divided into ritually clean and unclean (OK and NOT OK)

The food laws are NOT primarily about hygiene, or other rational/logical means


The concept of clean/unclean involving health issues as the reason for God's choices first appeared in the Middle Ages

IT'S ALL ABOUT HOLINESS!

- The dietary laws are one of the components of God's people maintaining their holiness
- BUT.....it MUST be done within the context of loving and trusting Yehoveh or it has no value
- The Lord DECLARES what is holy
- Man may NOT decide for ourselves what is holy and what is not



DEUTERONOMY 14: FOOD LAWS



- To'evah = abhorrent, abominable, disgusting
- Especially unclean or unholy
- ALL unclean foods are to'evah
- Edible items that are considered UNCLEAN are not classified as "food"




PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF CLEAN ANIMAL



SWARMING

- Swarming creatures are UNCLEAN
- Swarming = sherets
- Means it moves at random, darts about, crawls
- Frogs, mice, rats, ants

SHELLIFISH

CONDITIONS WHEN A CLEAN ANIMAL BECOMES UNCLEAN

- When an otherwise clean animal dies of natural causes or accident or killed by wild animal, it is considered UNCLEAN
- May be given to a ger, or sold to a nokri
- Ger = non-Hebrew living among Israel
- Nokri = non-Hebrew living OUTSIDE the camp
- This is NOT about the meat becoming unhealthy


RULES OF THE RABBIS




- Moses probably wouldn't have recognized the food laws found in the Talmud
- The Rabbis greatly expanded and inflated the food laws
- Yeshua directly addressed this issue

PETER'S VISION

- The unclean animals were a metaphor for gentiles
- Duane Christensen: "Peter's vision..... primarily symbolic.....of including the gentile man....with the people of God..."
- Tradition had made all gentiles inherently UNCLEAN
- Kosher laws made eating with a gentile practically impossible
- Kal V'homer = light vs. heavy





SOCIAL JUSTICE

- Hebrews have always put an emphasis on social justice
- Christian doctrines often pick one scripture verse to focus on and diminish others creating an unbalanced approach
- Jews have historically overbalanced fairness and social justice at the expense of God's laws and commands
- Joshua and his successors would allow intermarriage, pagan worship, etc. in order to achieve their ideas of social justice
- Modern Israel is driven to selfdestruction with the same intent

DON'T NEGLECT LEVITES

- ➤ Tithe (1/10th) to be brought to the Tabernacle EVERY YEAR
- Every 3 years the tithe was so be stored locally
- Food and money for poor, widows, orphans, strangers
- Priests = temple officials
- Levites = temple workers
