

# BLESSINGS AND CURSES 

> Israel was to "listen" to God via the Laws and Commands of the Torah
> Most answers about God's will for our lives is already established for us to read in His Word
$>$ Curses are the opposite of blessings
> Tokhehah = Warning

# THE 2nd GENERATION RECEIVES THE LAW 

$>$ Moses is re-teaching the Law
$>1$ st Exodus generation is dead > PRINCIPLE: We are redeemed NOT by what our parents agreed to and did, but what WE agree to and DO!
> First 6 curses are mirror opposites of the first 6 blessings
> Obedience and disobedience brings opposite results

## $>$ Curse, cumbrance, and confusion

- Me'erah = curse, bearing a calamity

Mehumah = confusion, panic and chaos

Mig'eret = cumbrance,
a heavy burden, frustration

## FORSAKING THE LORD

$>$ Abandoning God
> Does NOT mean to completely renounce Him
> Does NOT mean to exchange Yehoveh for another god
> Means to turn our backs on Him, quit obeying
> Dilute our lives with things of the world that
 have no place in the life of a Believer!


## DISEASE, DROUGHT, WAR

$>$ Diseases called: Shahafet, kaddahat, dallaket
$>$ We're not sure of their modern equivalents
> Brass sky, iron earth means no rain and parched ground
$>$ March in by 1 road, flee by 7 roads means Hebrews will be running for their lives
> So many dead, the birds will eat the corpses before they can be buried!

## CURSES OF EGYPT UPON ISRAEL


$2^{\text {nd }}$ generation had not witnessed the horrors of Egypt
God threatens Israel with the same plagues if they rebel against Him
Israelites will become psychologically tormented "blindness" does not mean loss of eyesight; it means spiritual blindness
> The absence of God
...nothing will make sense anymore.....
> Your worst fears will be realized
> People will hate you, but WHY?
$>$ EXILEE!
$>$ This becomes inevitable
> Prophetic
> Israel taken captive by a nation that did not exist at the time of the Patriarchs


## ISRAEL IS DIVIDED INTO TWO KINGDOMS


$>$ Solomon dies in 925 B.C.
Judah controls the south Judah absorbed Benjamin

Ephraim controls the north
Ephraim absorbed the other 10 tribes

## CURSES WILL FOLLOW ISRAEL INTO EXILE

$>$ Jonah chapters 1 \& 2
$>$ There is NO running from God, ONLY running TO Him!
> Ancients (including Israel) believed their gods were bound by territory
> Jonah was trying to escape Yehoveh's jurisdiction
> Jonah was NOT renouncing YHWH

## ROLE REVERSAL

> God had ordered Israel to lend to the foreigners
$>$ Now the foreigners would lend to Israel
> Conquest by other nations
> Starvation, poverty, servitude
A All of these curses because Israel did not "SHEMA" to God
> The calamities upon Israel will serve as a "sign and wonder"


## GOD THREATENS TO REVERSE ISRAEL'S SALVATION HISTORY!

$>$ To receive the blessing of the Lord but have no joy, to not be grateful for our redemption by means of obedience is to invite God's curses!
> The New Testament warns that some who believed Messiah would renounce Him!
> Luke 8:13 " ...those seeds who fell on rocky soil.....belfeve for a while....then fall away.."
> Rom. 11:22 'f.......to you God's kindness if you continue......otherwise you also will be cut off.....

# OBEDIENCE TO THE LAW DOES NOT BRING JUSTIFICATION!! 

> Gal. 5:4 "....you who are trying to be declared righteous....through legalism....have severed yourself from Messiah..."
> Rev. 2:4 "....you have lost your first love...remember where you were before you fell.....otherwise I will come and remove your menorah.....
> 1 Tim. 4:1 si...in later times some will fall away.....paying attention to.....doctrines..."

## THERE IS HOPE IF YOU'VE FALLEN AWAY!!


> A Believer who renounces his faith CAN return
$>$ James 5:19 "...if one of you wanders from the truth.....whoever turns a sinner from his wandering path will save him from death.,"

## THE FALL OF ISRAEL

Siege warfare is described
> Cannibalism
> Extra-Biblical records show that these acts of desperation to avoid starvation actually occurred
> Vs. 68 states that the covenants of Horeb and Moab both stand (as they are the same)
> God does NOT form a new covenant by revoking the previous one
