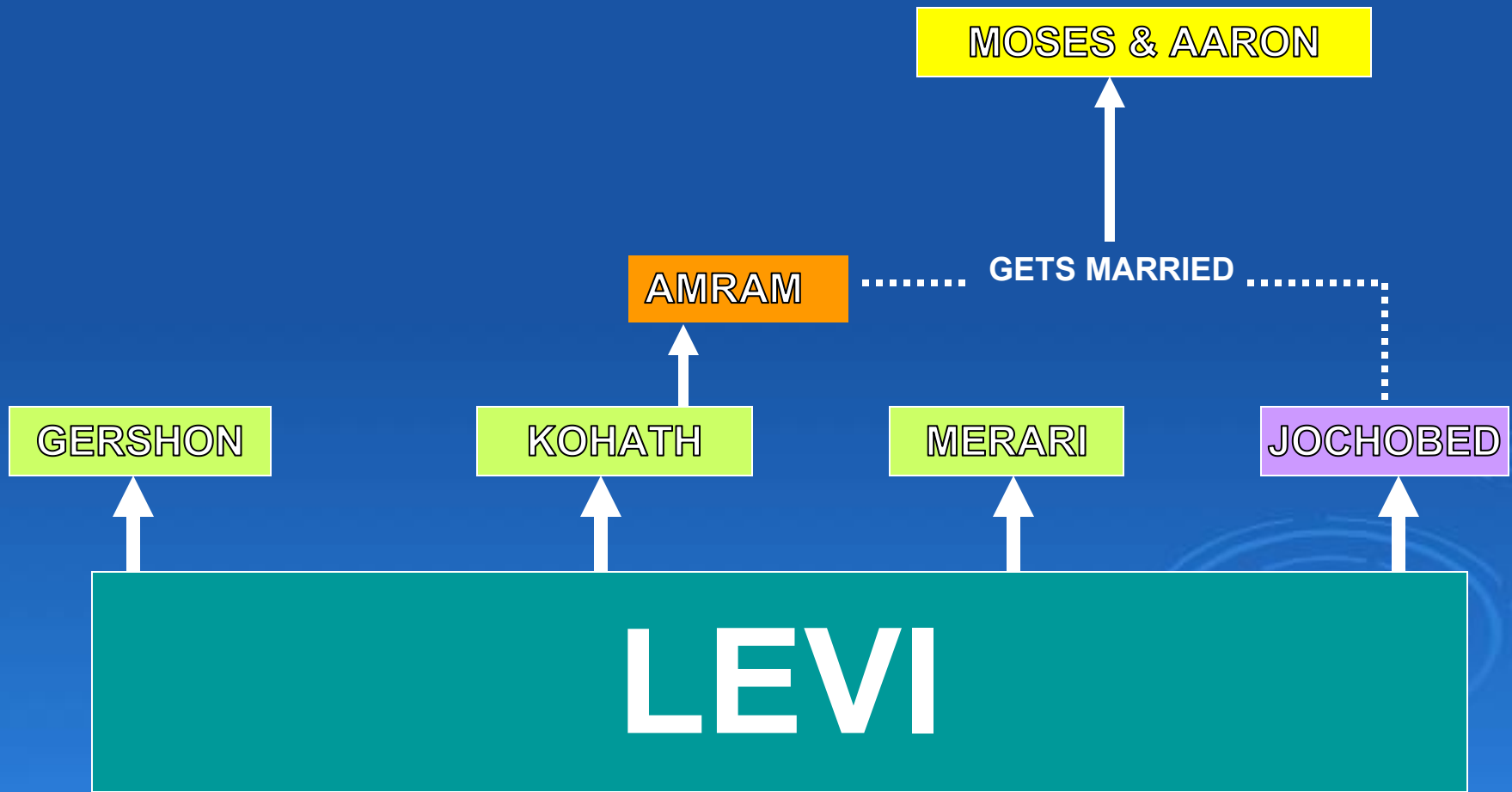


EGYPT HAS A NEW KING



- New Pharaoh is Egyptian
- Didn't honor agreements with Joseph
- Pharaoh concerned with maintaining national sovereignty
- Hebrew generally hung on to their culture
- Pharaoh attempted to control the Hebrews' population
- Enslavement was part of the plan

EXODUS CHAPTER 2



MOSES' ARK



- Parents hide Moses for about 3 months
- Put him in waterproofed basket and set it in the Nile
- **Tov** = good
- Genesis, God pronounces each step of His Creation as “**tov**”, good
- Basket made of Papyrus reeds
- Noah's Ark = **tevah**
- Moses' Ark = **tevah**

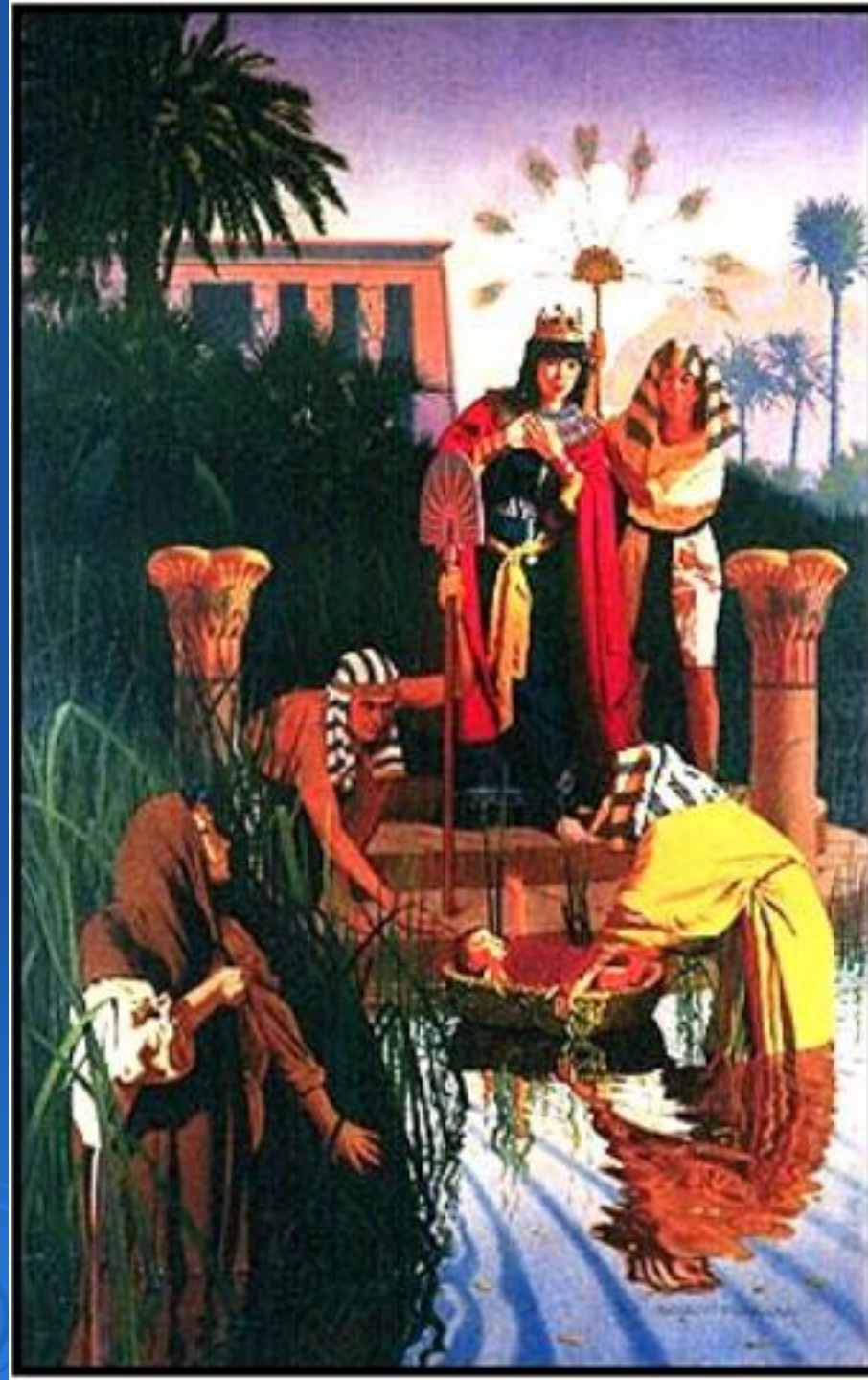
THE 2 ARKS

- Parallel purposes
- Noah; salvation of the human race
- Moses: salvation of Israel
- Water and an ark as the focal point in both cases
- *Tevah* = ark
- Ark of Covenant an entirely different “ark”
- ‘*aron*’ = coffin
- ‘*aron*’ = chest where 10 Commandments were held

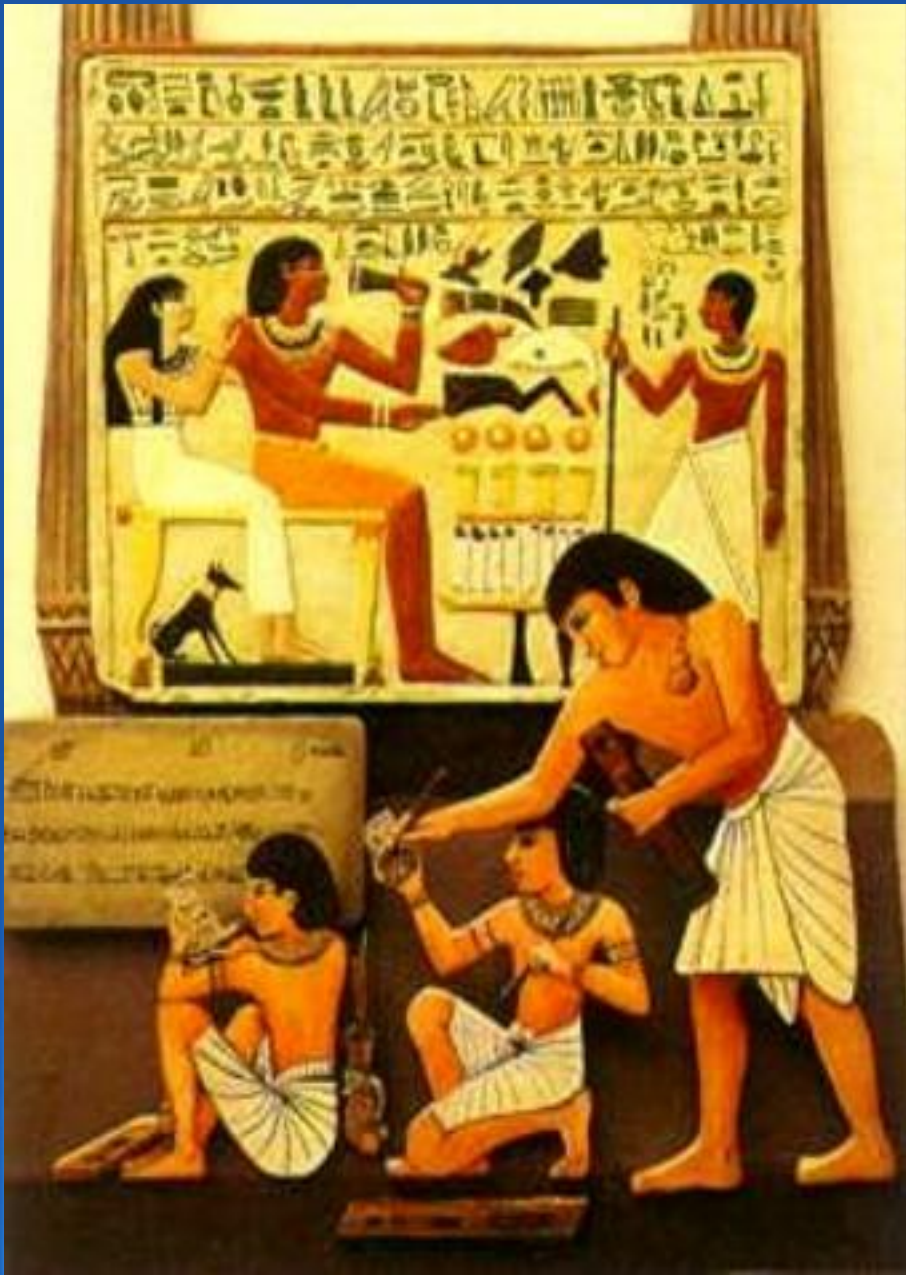


PHARAOH'S DAUGHTER FINDS MOSES

- She knew this was a Hebrew baby
- Miriam suggests Princess use a Hebrew wet-nurse
- Moses' own mother raises him, as a PAID position!



MOSES RAISED IN PALACE



- After weaning, Moses returned to Princess
- Nursing often lasted until age 5
- Must have caused great psychological tension
- **Mose** = son, child (Egyptian)
- **Mosheh** = drawn out (Hebrew)
- **Ra-mose** = Rameses = son of the god Ra

MOSES ERUPTS

- Moses ALWAYS knew he was a Hebrew
- Not fully welcomed as a Hebrew or Egyptian
- Kills an Egyptian guard who was beating a Hebrew slave
- 2 Israelites saw Moses commit the murder

MOSES MEETS TZIPPORA



- The water well was a common meeting place
- Moses drives off the bully shepherds
- Moses looked Egyptian
- Tziphora's father is Reuel
- **Reuel** = friend of EL
- Gershom is born to Moses
- **Ger-shom** = a stranger there
- **Tziphora** = bird

GOD REMEMBERS ISRAEL

- Pharaoh dies
- But, the new Pharaoh still enslaves Israel
- **Zakar** = remember
- An active term, which means to pay close and attention AND to become involved
- Yehoveh's reaction revolved around the covenant He gave to Abraham, Isaac & Jacob

EXODUS CHAPTER 3: MOSES IN MIDIAN



- Moses becomes a shepherd
- Did not own his own animals, they belonged to his father-in-law
- Moses moved flocks to area of Mt. Horeb
- Reason for move was new pasture

WHERE MOSES WAS TAKING FLOCK WAS SAME PLACE AS HE TOOK ISRAEL ON THE EXODUS
