

GENESIS 27: THE BLESSING

 God had already made




THE BIRTHRIGHT IS NOT THE <u>REAL</u> ISSUE IN THIS SCENE

- Matter of who would be Bekhor had ALREADY been settled
- NAS Genesis 27:36 ...for he has supplanted me these two times? He took away my birthright....now he has taken away my blessing."
- The Blessings and the Birthright are not necessarily connected
- The Birthright was established at the BIRTH of the heir



BLESSING AND BIRTHRIGHT ARE SEPARATE MATTERS



- Generally, birthright was NOT decided near the end of the life of current family leader
- Firstborn did NOT get everything
- Double portion could mean exactly double, but there was great latitude
- Matter in this chapter is about division of wealth



ISAAC IS 137 YEARS OLD!

- Esau and Jacob were NOT kids!
- They were probably 77 years old
- Rivka decided to help God, by means of deception
- Does the end justify the means?


JACOB DECEIVES ISAAC




- Berakhah = blessing
- > THINKING it is Esau, Isaac blesses Jacob
- > This was NOT about being the bekhor
- This WAS about Isaac intending on giving Esau rights and privileges that rightfully should have been Jacob's

THE DEED IS DONE

- Jacob would have no sense of joy or humility
- Jacob's deception was SIN
- Esau comes back from the hunt, and discovers that he's been duped
- Esau says TWO things have been taken from him,
 1) birthright,
 2) blessing
- Esau didn't want to be the bekhor, he just wanted the STUFF!




ISAAC BLESSES ESAU




- Isaac is limited in what he can do for Esau
- Blessings are NOT reversible
- VS. 39 (traditional) "Your home will be the richness of the earth and the dew of heaven from above"
- LITERALLY; "Behold, <u>AWAY</u> from the richness of the earth and <u>AWAY</u> from the dew of heaven will be your home"


EDOM'S "BLESSING" WAS ACTUALLY A "CURSE"



RASHI 11TH CENTURY AD

- Witnessed the Crusades
- Saw Esau as a "type"
- Equated Esau with the Catholic Church and Rome
- Rashi has much to do with modern-day Judaism views
- Rashi had sympathy for Esau's plight YET
- He also knew Esau's destiny was to be Israel's enemy





HAD ESAU BEEN <u>HAPPILY</u> BLESSED, HE WOULD NOT WANT TO KILL JACOB!

- ➤ Esau = Edom
- King Herod the "Idumaean"
- Idumaea is Greek for Edom
- > Esau mixed with the descendants of Ishmael
- Much of the Arab world carries the genes of Esau
- > Ottoman Turks, Syrians, Kurds of Iraq
- Turkey to play large role in End Times
- Majority of Muslims are related to Esau
