

GENESIS CHAPTER 40 JOSEPH IN PRISON

Joseph is 28 years old

- Did Joseph believe those old dreams were still valid?
- Cup-bearer and baker were high positions
- Not held in regular prison, but in captain of the guard's house



THE BAKER AND THE CUPBEARER



- Dreams once again enter the picture
- Men were troubled because the Seer was not available to them
- > Cupbearer goes first
- Good news: within 3 days he will be restored to his position
- Bad news for the baker: in 3 days he will die

EGYPTIAN MEN CARRIED BASKETS ON THEIR HEAD


- Women carried baskets on hip or shoulder
- Egyptians carried baskets the opposite way of Oriental cultures
- Joseph asked cupbearer to remember him
- Cupbearer forgot about Joseph



GENESIS 41 THE HYKSOS



> At the time of Joseph, Semites ruled Egypt The Pharaoh was NOT Egyptian, but was a Semite Israel was free and prosperous in Egypt for a long time



- Manetho, Egyptian historian
- Conquering Semite king named Salitis
- Egypt humiliated by being over-run by these uncivilized hoards
- Divine Providence allowed Joseph to rise to power


Avaris became home to the Hebrews
 Located in Goshen
 Salatis stationed 240,000 soldiers there

Nile

THE PHARAOH'S DREAMS



Joseph now 30 years old Dreams disturb Pharaoh because they seem so real \succ He calls his magicians, who are really his brain-trust Mystery Babylon religion was part of Egyptian life > Wise men were the intellectuals > His men cannot interpret the dreams

JOSEPH INTERPRETS PHARAOH'S DREAMS

- Joseph admits it is not he but God who interprets
- > Prophetic dreams
- > First dream: Cows
- > 7 healthy, 7 sickly
- Second dream: Corn
- > 7 healthy, 7 sickly
- > 7 abundant years, then 7 years of famine







PLAN FOR THE FAMINE

- > 20% of all produce is to be stored
 - People not thrilled because they couldn't enjoy their abundance
- A Hyksos plan, led by Joseph to take wealth from the people?
- Pharaoh had FAITH!!
- Our time of plenty is now
- Ahead lies our greatest trial
- We know the truth and better heed it


JOSEPH THE VIZIER

Pharaoh selects Joseph to run the nation

Joseph's Egyptian name: Zaphenath-Panea

Meant: "he who is called life" in Egyptian

> A name indicated reputation, status



JOSEPH IS GIVEN A WIFE

- Wife is Asenath, daughter of the High Priest of On
- On was the Temple of the Sun-God Re
- > On also called Heliopolis
- > Two sons born to Joseph: Ephraim and Manasseh
- These are Egyptian children
- Joseph sees Egypt as a friend, a replacement home




Inscription of 7 year famine

EGYPTIAN VAULTED GRANARIES

The famine strikes

- NOT a world-wide famine, primarily Middle East
- Panim of the eretz = face of the land
- Stored grain was sold back to the people
- People ran out of money, sold themselves into bond-servitude to Pharaoh for food
